



## ISHL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS

The ISHL is a non-profit ice hockey organization for high school players in the Greater Houston area that awards academic scholarships to qualified seniors who were participants in and in good standing with the ISHL Justice Varsity League for the current school year. You must be a graduating senior to apply. Scholarships will be awarded in May of the current school year. All applicant information will be completely confidential.

### Qualifications are based on the following in order of priority.

1. **ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:** The ISHL is a strong supporter of academic excellence and the discipline and hard work required to excel in high school and meet strict college admission standards.
2. **COMMUNITY SERVICE:** The ISHL recognizes that community service builds strong individuals committed to excellence and opportunity for all. Consideration will be given to volunteer service in the community as well as in school sponsored volunteer organizations. For example, volunteer service may be performed through hospitals, religious groups, volunteer tutoring and community sponsored charitable projects.
3. **LEADERSHIP/EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** The ISHL commends students that take the role of leaders in organizations and recognizes the commitment that is required.
4. **ESSAY:** The essay is the student's opportunity to express why they should be the recipient of an ISHL scholarship and what it would mean to them.
